





Room dimensions



Room dimensions






The University of Akron offers one of the best values in higher education throughout Ohio.

UA's Tuition Guarantee Program

Designed for undergraduate students, UA's Tuition Guarantee Program helps you plan and predict the costs of a four-year college education. This program provides fixed tuition, select fees and room-and-board rates for four years.

Submit your high school transcript (your high school counselor can help with this).

Important application information:

- · No application fee
- · Test-optional*
 - If you plan to apply to the Williams Honors College or be considered for direct admission to the School of Nursing, you must submit your test score.
- · Letters of recommendation not required
- No essays

***UA is a test-optional institution.** This means you're not required to submit ACT or SAT test scores to be considered for admission. All students, whether or not test scores are submitted, will be considered for merit-based scholarships.
